### **Course description**

This course is designed to enable participants to build upon their basic foundation in homiletics. There will be a discussion of the principles of hermeneutics, examining the various hermeneutical approaches and methods of interpretation and how these apply to the task of sermon preparation. Particular attention will be given to the interpretation and appropriate application of Narrative and Prophets (OT), Gospels and Epistles (NT). Participants will be actively involved in the exegesis, the homiletical considerations, and the process of sermon preparation and delivery.
