COURSE DESCRIPTION

The books of Kings in the Hebrew Bible contains great lessons in the salvific history of Israel and Judah, valuable to Christians for the understanding and appreciation of God's everlasting love and mercy for His people. In "Exegesis of 1 & 2 Kings," an overview of the books will be presented with related scholarly input and critique. Students will be guided through practical exegetical exercise to acquire knowledge and exegetical skills to expound lessons from the text of the books. Students will also learn to extract spiritual lessons from the books of Kings and construct expository sermon for effective teaching of God's Word to His people.
