A study of 1 Corinthians will show how the church in Corinth met with controversial problems that have a very modern ring: divisions within the church, ministerial favoritism, moral failure, spiritual elitism, excessive charismatic expression, theological heresy, and failed financial pledge. Encounter with this letter thus shows how "biblical" modern church problems can be.

The course is thus an exercise in applied hermeneutics where we will bring all our exegetical and modern technological resources together in an exegetical study of this fascinating letter.

For this course, students are required to have some knowledge of New Testament background and some grasp of approaches to biblical interpretation.
