The Epistle of James: The Voice of the Lord's Brother?

4 cr hours

Course Description

The course will deal with historical and theological problems related to the letter of James that leads the collection of non-Pauline letters ("Catholic Epistles") in the New Testament canon. As a letter sent from Jerusalem to the "Twelve tribes in dispersion", the short text enables us to get a glimpse of the vitality and the challenges of groups of adherents of Jesus Christ in the earliest period of emerging Christianity. Living in the diaspora, they count themselves to being part of the people of Israel and seek to follow the will of God as expressed in the Jewish law. At the same time, they found their faith, as does the letter writer, in "God and the Lord Jesus Christ" (see Jas 1:1; 2:1). The aim of the letter is to strengthen the addressees in their faith, to counsel them in their hardships and to correct them in their way of life, in particular with regard to their dealing with the poor and helpless among them.

The Lecturer

- Prof. Dr. Karl Willheim Niebuhr

Born in Neuruppin, Germany, Prof. Dr. Karl Willheim Niebuhr is married with four children. He studied theology at Martin-Luther-Universität Halle-Wittenberg, earning his Doctor of Theology in 1986 and being ordained in the Lutheran Church the same year. He served as a research assistant and later as an Assistant Professor for New Testament at Halle University from 1981 to 1994. Dr. Niebuhr then became Professor of Biblical Theology at Technische Universität Dresden (1994-1996) and later held a long-term position as Professor of New Testament at Friedrich-Schiller-Universität Jena from 1997 to 2022. He received a Medal of Honor from Comenius University and an Honorary Doctorate from the University of Sofia. Since 2022, he has been a Senior Professor of New Testament at Jena, a role he will hold until 2027.

Course Description

This is an advanced ministerial studies core module to enhance students' skills in hermeneutics and exegesis, leading to sermon preparation and exegetical preaching. This module will involve a high interaction among the students and the lecturers, particularly the discussions on observed problems with regards to biblical interpretation, exegetical challenges and sermon preparations. The students are expected to engage with difficult texts in the Old Testament and do substantial readings for the purpose of forming a critical analysis based on exegetical and theological interpretations.

The Lecturer - Ps. Dr. Elaine Goh

Pr Dr Elaine Wei-Fun GOH is a faculty in the Old Testament Studies and the Dean of Centre of Postgraduate Studies at Seminari Theoloji Malaysia (STM). She earned her Doctor of Theology from South East Asia Graduate School of Theology/ATESEA Theological Union and her main area of research is in the Old Testament studies. She has authored several published book titles, journal articles and commentaries, and is also a recipient of the 2023 Outstanding Mentor Award by Status of Women in the Profession Committee, Society of Biblical Literature, awarded on 20 November, 2023 at San Antonio, Texas, United States.

Course Description


This course examines the role of pastoral care in supporting individuals with mental health challenges, focusing on spiritual guidance, emotional support, and ethical approaches in diverse contexts. It explores both practical and theological implications for understanding and responding to complex mental health issues. By the end of the course, students will gain a deeper understanding of the relationship between mental health and spirituality, develop skills in crisis intervention and pastoral counseling, and learn to recognize ethical boundaries in mental health care.

Bishop Steven Abbarow, the Bishop of the Diocese of West Malaysia, has a BEcons (University of Malaysia, 1985), an MDiv (Seminari Theoloji Malaysia, 1989), a MTheol (South East Asia Graduate School of Theology, 2002), and a DMin (Perkins Divinity School of Southern Methodist University, 2016).

Course Description

This course explores the theological, pastoral, and practical aspects of ageing and end-of-life issues from a Christian perspective. Students will examine biblical views on ageing, develop practical skills for ministering to older adults, and address ethical considerations in end-of-life care. The course aims to equip students with both theological, theoretical knowledge and hands-on skills for effective ministry to the elderly.

Susan Chan is a Bible teacher, adjunct college professor, itinerant preacher, conference speaker, and corporate trainer. Her scholarly interests include researching the topic of positive aging, which culminated in her doctoral thesis titled "Ageing Positively and the Role of the Church." She earned her Doctor of Ministry degree from AGST, reflecting her commitment to both academic excellence and practical ministry.



- Dr. Wong Moi Lee

A guest lecturer at STM, teaching modules like Basic Counselling, Bereavement Care, & Spiritual Formation. She retired from STM as the English TEE director in 2019. Her ministry experiences include over 30 years of pastoral care and church planting. Today, she mentors workers directly involved in pioneering churches at Kuching. Dr. Wong is also a DMin thesis supervisor with AGST - Alliance and the author of "Walking through Grief". Another passion of hers is ministering to believers in need of wholeness and conducting private spiritual retreats. She currently serves in the LifeCare team at Sg. Way Subang Methodist Church.

当代教会崇拜议题的探索与反思

课程描述

敬拜是基督徒极关重要且不可停歇的信仰操练。在过去的2000多年, 随著福音被广传至各地, 不同时空的教会所进行之集体敬拜模式时而大相径庭, 时而相互趋同, 并且在此历史进程中演化出各类的敬拜神学, 并产生了许多与敬拜相关的教牧议题。

本课程分成二个阶段, 第一阶段以敬拜的圣经原则、神学建构、及历史演进为基础, 奠定学员从事敬拜研究的根基; 第二阶段将提供学员关于当代敬拜议题的相关文章或报导, 带领学员透过研读、观察、模拟体验与课堂讨论, 从处境及文化的角度探索当代敬拜的多元面貌, 深度剖析并反思近代礼拜之各项议题所反映出的神学立场、文化背景与更新、以及信仰传承与实践等层面, 借以探讨现代教会在当前处境之下, 该如何面对并回应礼拜学相关议题的挑战, 并转化为教会质与量成长的契机。


